## Lane Closures

This improvement project includes a detailed Traffic Control Plan that will maintain traffic flow through the construction zone.

Northbound single lane closures from Sunflower Lane to Wakulla Lane are restricted to:  
**9:00 p.m. - 6:30 a.m.**

Northbound from 16<sup>th</sup> Street to S 1<sup>st</sup> Street have no lane closure restrictions.

Access to residences and businesses on the east side of A1A will be maintained at all times. Should it be necessary to close a driveway to perform project-related work, project personnel will coordinate with the property owner in advance.

## Project Description:

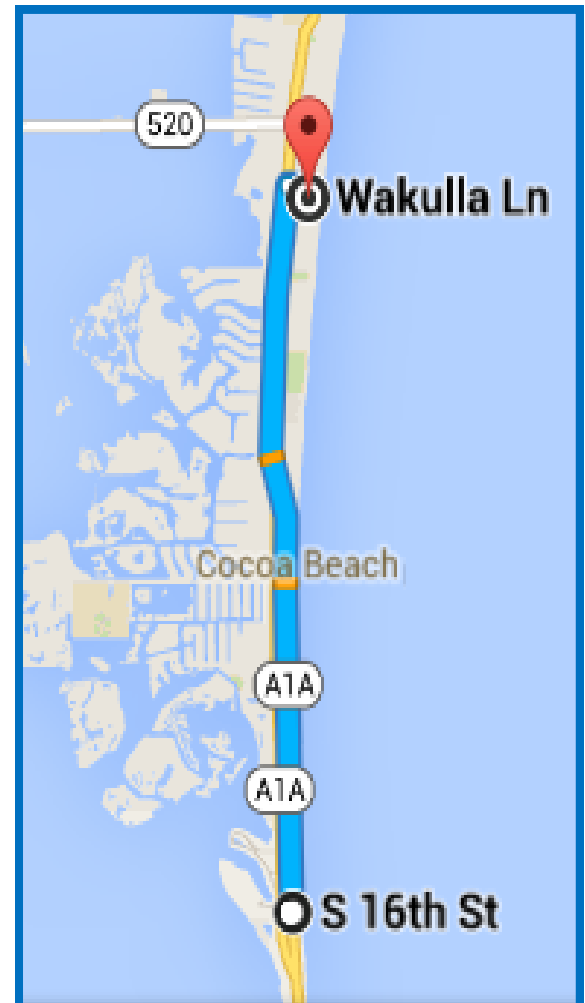
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and American Lighting and Signalization Inc. will begin to replace the existing asphalt sidewalk and build new, concrete sidewalks along the northbound/beachside lanes of SR A1A in Cocoa Beach from 16th Street to Wakulla Lane.

The cost is approximately \$1.2 million. The project will begin Fall 2014 with completion in the summer of 2015, weather permitting.

The construction is designed to improve area pedestrian traffic, driveway entries, drainage and safety conditions. The new and replaced sidewalk will be constructed to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Residential and business pedestrian traffic and vehicular entry will be affected. Please be aware of closures, detours and temporary pedestrian and traffic control devices including barricades and railings.

Landscape or hardscape, including irrigation lines and mailboxes, currently in the state right-of-way should be relocated prior to construction.
