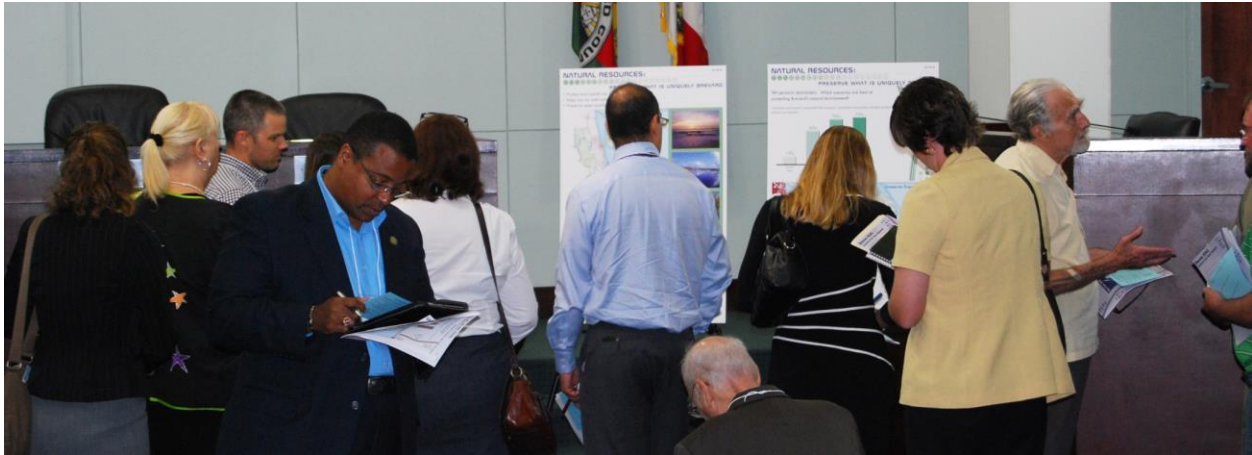

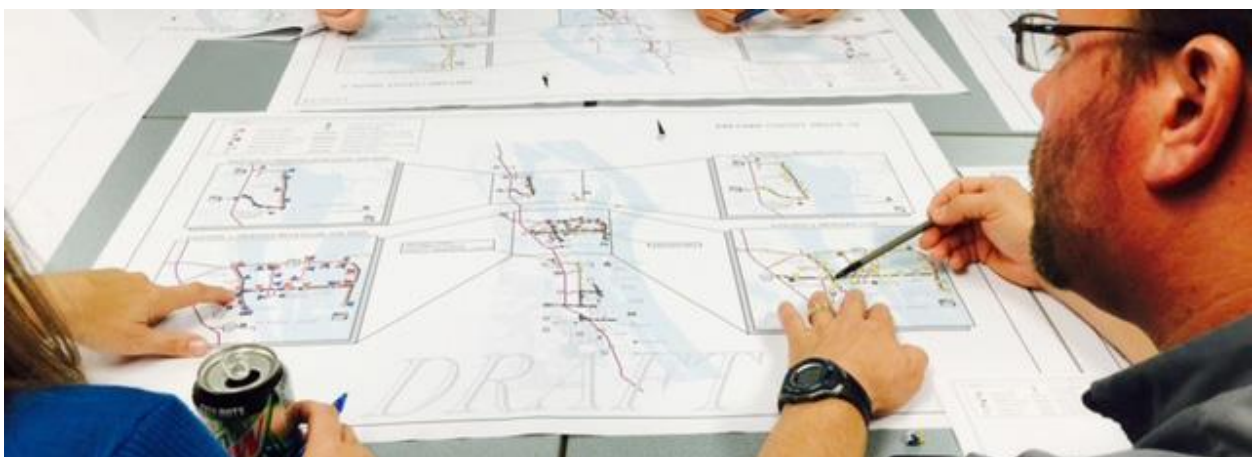

On September 9, the TPO Board will vote on adoption of the Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Master Plan. Through effective use of technology, Intelligent Transportation Systems improve traffic flow, safety, air quality and fuel efficiency. The ITS Master Plan outlines a strategy for development and maintenance of Brevard County's ITS network.

CORRIDOR STUDIES UNDERWAY



A number of kickoff meetings have been held recently in the new FDOT Corridors Planning Program. In this program, higher volume roadways that did not meet Complete Streets criteria are assessed. The focus is on understanding the underlying problem and then identifying possible solutions.

Corridors in this Program include:

- Eau Gallie Boulevard (Bridge to SR A1A)
- Fiske Boulevard (Barnes to SR 520)
- Garden Street (West of I-95 to US 1)
- SR 3 (Fortenberry to Grant)
- SR 520 (US 1 to the Causeway)
- US 1 (Laurel Place to Indian River Avenue)
- Sarno Road (Wickham to US 1)
- Banana River Drive/Pinetree Drive (Mathers Bridge to SR A1A)
