## Cameron Preserve 7am–6pm Daily FREE



Cameron Preserve offers natural trails marked for hikers, mountain bikers and equestrians. Enjoy wooded areas and open Florida scrub that support amazing biodiversity. Sections of some trails are stabilized and many connect to neighboring conservation lands for more enjoyment.

Orient yourself to the map at the trailhead, located at the north end of Corey Rd. Cell signal can be weak on the trails, so download maps via smartphone using the QR codes at the trailhead. No restrooms, potable water or horse paddocks available, but a public restroom is located at Malabar Community Park. Free parking.



Pet friendly but please keep under control and pick up after them.  
No potable water or restrooms. Bring water.
