Free guided tour of Crane Creek and the Crane Creek Nature Sanctuary managed under the Environmentally Endangered Lands Program Referendum. Learn about the EEL Program and the wildlife and habitat management of the sanctuary.

This will be a 3-mile paddle with a 3/4-mile easy hike. A limited supply of kayaks is available but must be reserved in advance. Participants may bring their own kayak, canoe or stand up paddle board. This is a paddle of moderate difficulty only due to the distance being paddled. Bring hat, walking shoes or sport sandals, sunscreen, water, snacks and dry bag. Free parking.
