## A. Max Brewer Bridge Open Daily FREE



The Max Brewer Bridge crosses the scenic Indian River Lagoon in Titusville. It is a destination spot for viewing rocket launches from Kennedy Space Center (KSC). A pull-off viewing area is available on the south side of the bridge, which offers fantastic views of wildlife in the lagoon, plus the Vehicle Assembly Building at KSC. Wide bike lanes and separate sidewalk make this a great destination.

Free parking and public restrooms available at Sand Point Park, adjacent to the bridge. Pet friendly - pet waste stations are at each end of the bridge. Bridge is open to the elements, so consider proper clothing and sun protection.
