The Pineapple Avenue Bike Pathway parallels the Indian River Lagoon with scenic views. Pineapple Park serves as the southern terminus, with Wickham Park at the northern terminus. The pathway can start at either park and traverses a suburban area. A sidewalk is located along Pineapple Avenue, making it suitable for walking and running. A variety of recreational opportunities are offered at both parks including playgrounds, picnic tables, fishing pier, and plenty more.

Public restrooms available at both parks. Free parking. The Pathway crosses two busy roads. Pathway can be shortened by turning around at any point. Pineapple Park is adjacent to downtown Eau Gallie.
