
Q. Who is the Space Coast Transportation Planning Organization?

- A. The Space Coast TPO is an organization comprised of 19 elected officials representing all areas of Brevard County.
- B. The TPO Board is responsible for coordinating and prioritizing transportation projects that are eligible for Federal and State funds.
- C. The TPO does not prioritize local neighborhood roads. Those are the responsibility of the your local city or county government.



Q. How did we get here? Why is Wickham Road being studied?

- A. 2014 TPO completed a countywide safety analysis
- B. 2015-16 TPO conducted safety audits on high crash corridors,
 Wickham Road being one of them issues identified
- C. 2017 TPO conducting analysis on Wickham Road to develop appropriate alternatives that can be implemented to address issues









Q. What are we studying?

- A. Signalized intersections: are they coordinated; are updated technologies needed; are pedestrian and bicycle facilities present;
- B. Along the Corridor: complete pedestrian facilities; bicycle lanes; safe places to cross; transit stops
- C. Next steps will be Design, Right-of-Way (Possibly), and then Construction
- D. Recommendations will be developed for short and long term (Short term solutions will not require right-of-way).
