Safety Performance Measure

A RESOLUTION, adopting the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Safety Performance Targets for 2022 and agrees to plan and program projects so that they contribute toward the accomplishment of the FDOT targets.

WHEREAS, the Space Coast Transportation Planning Organization is the designated and constituted body responsible for the urban transportation planning and programming process for the Palm Bay-Melbourne and Titusville Urbanized Areas; and

WHEREAS, the Fixing Americas Surface Transportation Act, continuing Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century’s overall performance management approach, requires state Department of Transportation’s to establish performance measures in a number of areas, including setting targets; and

WHEREAS, the FDOT adopted Safety Performance Target of zero fatalities and zero serious injuries for Calendar Year 2022; and

WHEREAS, the SPACE COAST TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION (TPO) wishes to establish and adopt the safety targets as those of the FDOT; and agrees to work with the State and safety stakeholders to address areas of concern, **while respecting citizen’s rights to privacy**, for fatalities or serious injuries within the metropolitan planning area.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Space Coast Transportation Planning Organization adopts the FDOT’s Safety Performance Targets.
