Ellis Road Widening

The SCTPO's #1 Priority Project is this vital connection between I-95, economic generators, and the Melbourne-Orlando International Airport. Right-of-Way acquisition is funded and underway while efforts continue to fully fund construction.



Traffic Management Center

Design is complete for a new regional Traffic Management Center and construction is currently funded for fiscal year 2024.
