FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION | WORK PROGRAM PUBLIC HEARING

District 5 Work Program Public Hearing for fiscal years 2016/2017 through 2020/2021 was held Thursday October 15, 2015 at the District headquarters office at 719 South Woodland Blvd. Deland, FL 32720 at 6pm and it was broadcast via webcast. Below is a highlight of some of the projects the Department is proposing to advance or Add to the work program for Brevard County.

PROJECT "A": FM#433654-1

This project is an Intersection improvement project on SR500/US192 at Wickham Rd. The design phase is being proposed to be advance for fiscal year 2016 for approximately \$487,000. The construction phase is being proposed to be advance for fiscal year 2018 for approximately \$1,007,675.

PROJECT "B": FM#433655-1

This project is an Intersection improvement project on SR500/US192 at Hollywood Blvd. The design phase is being proposed to be advance for fiscal year 2016 for approximately \$575,000. In addition, right of way is programmed in FY 2020 for \$4,837,000 and FY 2021 for \$1,222,000.

PROJECT "C": FM#431923-1

This project is an Intersection improvement project on Wickham Rd at Post. The construction phase is being proposed for fiscal year 2021 for approximately \$315,000 of County Incentive Grant Program with a local match of \$315,000.

PROJECT "D": FM#431924-1

This project is an Intersection improvement project on Wickham Rd at Eau Gallie south bound. The Right of Way phase is being proposed for fiscal year 2017 for approximately \$400,000 of County Incentive Grant Program with a local match of \$400,000.

PROJECT “E”: FM#431924-3

This project is an Intersection improvement project on Wickham Rd at Eau Gallie Northbound & Southbound. The Construction phase is being proposed for fiscal year 2020 for approximately \$719,820 of County Incentive Grant Program with a local match of \$689,820.

PROJECT “F”: FM# 437983-1

This is a widening project on SR524 from Friday Road to Industry Road. The Project Development and Environment Phase is being proposed in fiscal year 2019 for approximately \$ 1,738,000.

PROJECT “G”: FM# 437345-1

This is a resurfacing project on SR 50/Cheney Highway from Orange County Line to I-95 SB on Ramp. The design phase for this project is being proposed in fiscal year 2017 for approximately \$846,000 and the construction phase in fiscal year 2019 for approximately \$10,059,797.

PROJECT “H”: FM# 438478-1

This is a reconstruction and reconfiguration project on I-95 from NB Rest Area to SB Rest Area in Mims. The design phase for this project is being proposed in fiscal year 2018 for approximately \$2,030,000 and the construction phase in fiscal year 2021 for approximately \$28,770,040.

PROJECT “I”: FM# 437093-1

This project is an extension to the current Coast-to-Coast Project Development and Environmental project on from Max Brewer Causeway to Atlantic Ocean. A north/south extension being proposed to be included for fiscal year 2016 for approximately \$900,000.

PROJECT “J”: FM# 437594-1

This is a sidewalk safety project on Country Club Road from New Haven to Edgewater Dr. The design phase for this project is being proposed in fiscal year 2018 for approximately \$75,000 and the construction phase in fiscal year 2020 for approximately \$500,000.

PROJECT “K”: SPACEPORT PROJECTS:

In addition, to previously funded spaceport projects in fiscal years 2016-2020 for approximately \$20 million a year, another \$20 million are being proposed in fiscal year 2021 with individual capacity project to be identified at a later date.

As a reminder, all the projects that are being proposed above and are subject to change due to the Revenue Estimating Conference Forecasts and the Work Program Public Hearing comments.
