



RESOLUTION 19-07

RESOLUTION, adopting the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Safety (PM1), Bridge and Pavement (PM2) and System Performance (PM3) Targets and agrees to plan and program projects so that they contribute toward the accomplishment of the FDOT targets.

WHEREAS, the SPACE COAST TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION (TPO) is the designated and constituted body responsible for the urban transportation planning and programming process for the Palm Bay-Melbourne and Titusville Urbanized Areas; and

WHEREAS, the Fixing Americas Surface Transportation Act, continuing Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century's overall performance management approach, requires state Department of Transportation's to establish performance measures in a number of areas, including setting targets; and

WHEREAS, the FDOT adopted Safety (PM1), Bridge and Pavement (PM2) and System Performance (PM3) Targets for Calendar Year 2018, as detailed in Attachments "A" and "B"; and

WHEREAS, the SPACE COAST TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION (TPO) wishes to establish its safety, bridge and pavement, and system performance targets as those of the FDOT; and agrees to work with the State and stakeholders to address areas of concern within the metropolitan planning area; and

WHEREAS, the SPACE COAST TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION (TPO) will coordinate with the State to integrate the Safety (PM1), Bridge and Pavement (PM2) and System Performance (PM3) Targets measures and targets into the necessary planning processes and documents; and

WHEREAS, the SPACE COAST TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION (TPO) will continue to utilize and support the FDOT safety targets (PM1) established each calendar year until such time as the Space Coast TPO adopts its own targets.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the SPACE COAST TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION to adopt the FDOT's Safety (PM1), Bridge and Pavement (PM2) and System Performance (PM3) Targets.
